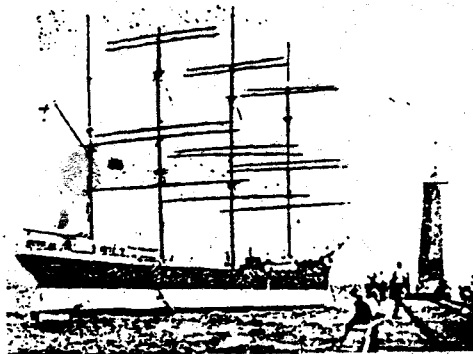

BLESSED BE YOUR NAME FOR EVER.

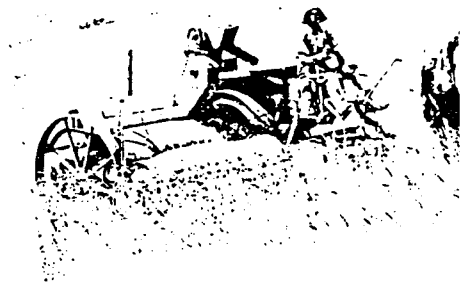
